In this connection, this Office respectfully requests **the Regional Office and the Schools Division of Antipolo City to host the activity**. - coordination assistance to facilitate **local preparations and on-site arrangements**.

Additionally, we request the SDO Antipolo City to utilize the downloaded CK operational funds for the showcase feeding activity during the National Launching.
