**Key Reminders and Next Steps for Khan Academy Implementation  
SY 2025–2026**

We cannot thank you enough for your continued support in helping us provide high-quality, skill-building learning experiences to our learners. To ensure a smooth and successful implementation, please be reminded of the following:

**1. Re-tagging of Khan Academy Classes (Deadline: July 31, 2025)**

All schools that participated in SY 2024–2025 are **required to re-tag their classes** on the Khan Academy platform. As of July 3, only 188 out of 1,400+ schools have done so. We ask for your help in ensuring that schools under your supervision complete this step **on or before July 31**.

Re-tagging is required to:

- Be officially included in the Khan Academy Philippines pilot program and qualify for **achievement incentives and nationwide recognition**
- Enable the Khan PH team to **monitor data and provide targeted support**
- Allow regional and division leaders to **track school progress**

All SY 2024–2025 schools that have not yet completed the retagging process are also invited to join a Facebook Live session through our official community group at <https://www.facebook.com/groups/khanphyear3>. The session will be conducted via Facebook Live within the group from 9:00 a.m. to 10:30 a.m., **July 19, 2025, Saturday**. There is no need for a separate meeting link, as the session will stream directly on the group page.

**2. Focal Person Commitment and Communication Channels**

We ask for your support in ensuring that all schools have active and responsive focal persons as **focal persons are a must for all our pilot schools**. All designated school focal persons are requested to **sign the official commitment form** for SY 2025–2026 to confirm their continued engagement.

**3. Training Needs: Venue, Connectivity**

We are grateful for your support in helping us find an airconditioned training venue for a maximum of 150 teachers, with at least 300 mbps in connectivity. **These are crucial to the success of our training so please ensure these are available before all trainings.**





#### 4. SY 2025–2026 Implementation Timeline

Below is a summary of the key phases of this year's implementation. Support is vital at each stage:

Phase	Status	Key Notes
Re-tagging	Ongoing – Until July 31	Required for returning schools to maintain active participation and performance data monitoring
Verification	Ongoing – Until July 12	Khan PH visits to assess infrastructure and readiness
Teacher Training	End June to Early December	In coordination with RDs/SDOs for venues and logistics
School Launch	Within one month after F2F training	Schools begin implementation of Khan Academy Time during at least one class period a week
Implementation & Monitoring	July onward until end of SY	Includes probationary period and continuous support from Khan PH

Please work closely with your focal persons and division teams to help schools stay on track throughout these phases.

#### 4. Application for NEAP CPD Units

Khan Academy PH training sessions are **eligible for CPD units recognition** under NEAP. However, as per NEAP guidance, **regional offices will be asked to apply directly to the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC). Please await for the NEAP memo that will be out this week related to this per NEAP's Asec Carmela Oracion and Alvin Fulgencio.**

To support you in this process, Khan Academy PH will provide: Official program flow, Attendance Records and Evaluation Results. Our POC from the Khan PH side is **Ms. Clarice Fajardo-Villanueva** ([clarice@khanacademyphilippines.org](mailto:clarice@khanacademyphilippines.org)).

We encourage all regions to **initiate applications early** so teachers may receive professional development credit for their participation.

#### 5. Quarterly Check-Ins with RDs, SDSs, and Focal Persons

To ensure continuous alignment and timely support, we are proposing **quarterly virtual check-ins** with Regional Directors, Superintendents, and focal persons.



These 1-hour meetings will cover: (1) Progress updates (e.g., verification, training, and implementation), (2) Field challenges and requests for support and (3) Upcoming initiatives and partnership opportunities
