KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

This contract is entered into this__ day of ______ 28 JUL 2025 by and between:

DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION REGIONAL OFFICE CALABARZON, a component field office of the government entity known as the Department of Education organized under existing Philippine laws with office address at Gate 2, Karangalan Village, Cainta, Rizal and herein represented by its Regional Director, ATTY. ALBERTO T. ESCOBARTE. It shall be referred in this agreement as the PROCURING ENTITY.

ELLADIA GENERAL MERCHANDISE an entity duly organized and existing under the Philippine laws, represented herein by its Sales Executive/Authorized Representative, **JESTONY NEPOMUCENO ABDON**, with office address at Block 2B, Lot 2, Phase 4, Grieg Street, Zabarte Road, North Olympus Subdivision, Brgy. Kaligayahan, Novaliches, Quezon City, herein after referred to as the SUPPLIER.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, on June 5, 2025, DepEd Regional Office IV-A CALABARZON has advertised its procurement activity for the PROCUREMENT OF SCIENCE AND MATHEMATICS EQUIPMENT (SME) PACKAGES TO PUBLIC ELEMENTARY, JUNIOR AND SENIOR HIGH SCHOOLS with reference number ROIVA-2025-02 in the PhilGEPS website, office website, and in conspicuous bulletin board of the Office.

WHEREAS, the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is SEVEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED EIGHTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED FIFTY-ONE PESOS AND 35/100 (Php7,988,451.35).

WHEREAS, the pre-procurement meeting was conducted on May 14, 2025, 10:00 am at the Regional Director Conference, DepEd Region IV-A CALABARZON, Gate 2 Karangalan Village, Cainta, Rizal.

WHEREAS, the Pre-bid Conference was conducted on April 16, 2025, 9:00 am at the Bulwagan ng Karangalan, DepEd Region 4A.

WHEREAS, the bid submission and opening of bids was conducted on June 30, 2025 at 9:00 am and the bid evaluation was conducted on July 1, 2025 at 9:00 am at the Regional Director's Conference Room, DepEd Region 4A.

WHEREAS, in response to the Invitation to Bid for the above mentioned procurement, the BAC received one (1) sealed bid, offering the following financial bid as read:

WHEREAS, using the checklist of required documents and taking into account the non-discretionary "Pass or Fail Criterion", the BAC found that **ELLADIA GENERAL MERCHANDISE** have complied with specifications issued by this Office.

WHEREAS, upon Post-Qualification proceedings and careful examination, validation and verification of all the eligibility, legal, technical, and financial requirements submitted by **ELLADIA GENERAL MERCHANDISE** has been found to be responsive.

WHEREAS, attached hereto is the Post-Qualification Report as Annex "A" and made an integral part hereof.

WHEREAS, the bid submitted by ELLADIA GENERAL MERCHANDISE is compliant with its proposal in the total amount of FOUR MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO PESOS (Php4,759,682.00).

WHEREAS, after review and deliberation on the proposal, **ELLADIA GENERAL MERCHANDISE** complied with the requirements and is hereby declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid (SCRB).

WHEREAS, on July 11, 2025, the Bids and Awards Committee of DepEd Region IV-A CALABARZON recommended to the head of the procuring entity the award of contract to ELLADIA GENERAL MERCHANDISE for the Procurement of Science and Mathematics Equipment (SME) Packages to Public Elementary, Junior and Senior High Schools with project identification number ROIVA-25-02 in the sum of FOUR MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO PESOS (Php4,759,682.00) (hereinafter called the "Contract Price").

WHEREAS, Notice of Award dated July 17, 2025 was issued;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the premises, the parties hereby agree as follows:

SECTION 1 Use of words

In this Agreement, words and expressions shall have the same meanings as those respectively assigned in the Philippine Bidding Document.

SECTION 2 Documents deemed part

All documents submitted by Supplier and all the documents released and issued by the Procuring Entity and its Bids and Awards Committee and Technical Working Group such as but not limited to:

- a) Invitation to Bid;
- b) Instructions to Bidders;
- c) Bid Data Sheet;
- d) General Conditions of Contract;

- e) Special Conditions of Contract;
- f) Schedule of Requirements;
- g) Technical Specifications;
- h) Notice of Award of Contract and the Bidder's conforme thereto;
- i) Performance Security;
- j) Supplier's Bid, including the Technical and Financial Proposals, and all other documents/statements submitted (e.g. bidders response to request to clarifications on the bid), including corrections to the bid resulting from the Procuring Entity's bid evaluation;
- k) Eligibility requirements, documents and/or statements;
- All other documents already submitted by the Supplier and to be required to be submitted after the perfection of this contract;

shall form part of this contract.

SECTION 3 Supplement to the Supplier's Obligation

In addition to the **Supplier**'s Obligations mentioned and stated in Section V (Special Conditions of the Contract) and Section VI (Schedule of Requirements) of the Philippine Bidding Documents and all other documents mentioned in Section II of this Contract, the **Supplier** shall also:

in accordance with the design and specification indicated in the Bidding Documents;

- b. The goods shall be delivered to the Twenty-two (22) Schools Division Offices (SDOs) CALABARZON.
- c. Comply to the lawful order of the **Procuring Entity** or its representative especially when the **Supplier** is made to answer in writing his failure to accomplish work in accordance to its schedule of delivery.
- d. Submit an accomplishment report when required by the **Procuring Entity** as part of its monitoring and evaluation.
- e. To execute and complete the project and remedy any defects therein in conformity with Item 5 of the General Conditions of the contract and 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184.

SECTION 4
Obligations of the Procuring Entity

The **Procuring Entity** hereby undertake to pay the **Supplier**, in consideration of the faithful and full performance of the **Supplier**'s obligations, the amount of **FOUR MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY-NINE THOUSAND SIX HUNDRED EIGHTY-TWO PESOS** (**Php4,759,682.00**) The terms of payment shall be in accordance with Item 2.2 of the Special Conditions of the Contract.

In case of partial or staggered delivery of the goods procured, the **Supplier** shall be paid the amount corresponding to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations and subject to the imposition of liquidating damages for goods delivered after the contract period.

SECTION 5 Monitoring and Validation of the Work Progress/Accomplishment

The **Procuring Entity** or its representative shall monitor the progress of the delivery. Beginning the commencement of the supply and delivery or from the last monitoring, the **Procuring Entity** or his representative may follow-up the progress of the delivery until all the uniforms are delivered within the contract period.

In case the supply and delivery has not been fully satisfied until the last day of the contract time, the **Procuring Entity** or his representative shall make the **Supplier** explain in writing and the **Procuring Entity** may opt to avail of legal remedies provided in Annex "I" of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184 and applicable laws, rules and regulations to make it sure that the interest of the government is protected.

SECTION 6 Settlement of Dispute

If any dispute of difference of any kind whatsoever shall arise between the parties in connection with the implementation of this contract, the parties shall make every effort to resolve amicably such dispute or difference by mutual consultation.

Any and all dispute arising from the implementation of this contract shall be submitted to arbitration in the Philippines according to the provisions of R.A. 876, otherwise known as the "Arbitration Law" and R.A. 9285, otherwise known as the "Alternative Dispute Resolution Act of 2004." By mutual agreement, the parties agree in writing to resort to other alternative modes of dispute resolution.

SECTION 7 Capacity and Authorization

Each of the parties to this contract hereby represents and warrants to the other that it is duly authorized and empowered to execute, deliver and perform this contract and that such action does not conflict with or violate any provision of law, regulation, policy, contract, deed of trust or other instrument to which it is a party or by which it is bound and that this contract constitutes a valid and binding obligation of it enforceable in accordance with its terms.
