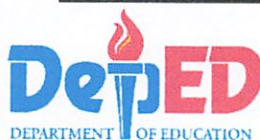

ADDENDUM TO REGIONAL MEMORANDUM NO. 527 S. 2025

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. Relative to Regional Memorandum No. 527, s. 2025, entitled "Regional Training on the Science of Reading for Early Language, Literacy, and Numeracy to Strengthen the Implementation of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning Program" scheduled on August 4–8, 2025, at Axiaa Hotel, Quezon City, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), provides additional information relative to the said activity.
