#### To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

3. By the end of the training program, the school leader-participants will be able to develop and present a context-based Professional Development Plan and a School Leadership Masterplan aligned with the Revised K to 10 Curriculum, using relevant tools, data, and stakeholder input.

Specifically, they will be able to:

to the

- a. empower school leaders in creating responsive, learner-centered environments by applying the principles of the Whole School Approach (WSA) in school operations, curriculum planning, and leadership practices aligned with professional standards;
- b. strengthen instructional coaching and supervision by using effective pedagogical frameworks;
- c. utilize assessment data for instructional decision-making and school-wide improvement;
- d. examine and develop teaching and learning resources aligned with curriculum standards;
- e. analyze school context and apply collaborative planning strategies;
- f. design context-based professional development plans aligned with teacher needs and curriculum demands;
- g. integrate performance data and documented practices into school leadership and supervision processes;
- h. apply monitoring and evaluation frameworks for sustainable leadership and school development; and,
- i. use school-based research and analytics to inform leadership decisions and improvements.
- 4. Target participants in the training are the **Public Schools District Supervisors**, **Education Program Supervisors** (from Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) and Schools Governance and Operations Division), and **School Heads** of elementary schools (K-6), junior high schools (7-10), and integrated schools (K-10, K-12, & 7-12).

- 5. Schools Division Offices (SDOs), through the Human Resource Development Section (HRDS) and CID, are requested to submit the Lists of Participants through tinyurl.com/4ASLRevisedK10 on or before August 18, 2025. Templates can be accessed at tinyurl.com/4ASLRevisedK10Paxs. Furthermore, SDOs shall decide who among their participants will be assigned per batch. Please see the first tab of each sheet/template.
- 6. The Lists of Participants and Additional Resource Persons per batch will be disseminated also in separate issuance.
- 7. Board and lodging expenses shall be charged against the Human Resource Development Fund (Program Support Fund), while travel expenses shall be charged against the funds to be downloaded, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
