STRUCTURAL VALIDATION OF SCHOOL BUILDINGS IN PREPARATION FOR THE POSSIBLE "BIG ONE" EARTHQUAKE

To: Schools Division Superintendents

- In reference to the DepEd Memorandum DM-OUHROD-2025-2872 dated September 12, 2025¹, this Office informs the Schools Division Offices of the conduct of joint structural validation and safety assessments of DepEd school infrastructure projects.
- This activity aims to assess the structural soundness of school buildings and strengthen preparedness measures in anticipation of the possible "Big One" earthquake.
- Relative to this, the Schools Division Offices (SDO) are instructed to do the following:
 - a. Coordinate closely with the Department of Public Works and Highways

 District Engineering Offices and the Local Government Unit Building
 Officials to jointly schedule and conduct on-site structural building validations;
 - b. Accomplish the Validation Form through this link: https://ee.kobotoolbox.org/x/K87osMvd to ensure standardized data collection and reporting, within fifteen (15) working days from receipt of this Memorandum; and
 - c. Prioritize school sites located within or near active fault lines, liquefaction-prone zones, or other high-risk areas as identified in PHIVOLCS and GeoRiskPH hazard maps.




In view of the recent typhoons and earthquakes that affected various areas of the country, this Department emphasizes the importance of ensuring the continued safety and structural integrity of all school buildings, particularly those implemented under the Basic Education Facilities Fund (BEFF) - New Construction of Classrooms.

This memorandum seeks to initiate joint structural validation and safety assessments of DepEd school infrastructure projects, in close coordination with the Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH) and the Local Government Unit (LGU) Building Officials. These validations aim to assess the structural soundness of school buildings and strengthen preparedness measures in anticipation of the possible "Big One" earthquake.

The initial phase of the validation shall cover priority areas, namely Bulacan (including cities within), Laguna (including cities within), and the National Capital Region (NCR). These provinces and regions have been identified as high-

risk zones based on their proximity to the West Valley Fault and other major fault lines.

In this regard, the concerned Regional Offices are instructed to do the following:

- Coordinate closely with their respective DPWH Regional and District Engineering Offices and the LGU Building Officials to jointly schedule and conduct on-site structural building validations;
- 2. Accomplish the Validation Form through this link: https://ee.kobotoolbox.org/x/K87osMvd to ensure standardized data collection and reporting, within fifteen (15) working days from receipt of this memorandum; and
- 3. Prioritize school sites located within or near active fault lines, liquefaction-prone zones, or other high-risk areas as identified in PHIVOLCS and GeoRiskPH hazard maps.

The EFD shall provide technical guidance, consolidate all regional submissions, and coordinate with the DPWH and concerned LGUs for necessary follow-through actions based on the validation results.


