- d. at the end of the scholarship or training grant, submit to the head of office and the Department of Education (DepEd) through the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) a copy of the scholarship report containing lessons for the conduct of echo seminars to share new learnings, teaching innovations, and strategies to their co-teachers and administrators; various trainings, program highlights and general impressions constituting (scholar's) evaluation of the program;
- e. upon return to their station, implement the echo seminars and submit reports to the Professional Development Division, National Educators Academy of the Philippines at Second Floor, Mabini Building, DepEd Complex, Meralco Avenue, Pasig City;
- f. shall teach the subject / conduct echo seminars on the course in which they were granted the scholarship and continue to serve their school / division / region for at

least three years which is the service obligation equivalent for a year of scholarship or a fraction thereof;


