- b. emphasize context-based implementation, as the ARAL Program should be flexible to local learner needs, not rigidly uniform;

- c. encourage collaboration between the Central Office-Regional Office-Schools Division Office-District-School levels for synchronized monitoring and technical assistance;
- d. integrate learner profiling and parent engagement into the ARAL Program monitoring; and
- e. conduct follow-up in-person monitoring visits after the technical session to validate actions taken.
- 3. Participants in this meeting are the members of the Regional Technical Working Group (RTWG) established for the ARAL Program, including the SDO ARAL Focal Person and their Alternate Focal Person/s.
- 4. All SDOs are directed to prepare and report issues, concerns, and challenges encountered in the ongoing implementation of the ARAL Program. These reports shall focus on field-level matters such as learner attendance, data accuracy, dashboard discrepancies, teacher workload, and classroom limitations, among others.
