ADMINISTRATION OF THE MIDDLE-OF-SCHOOL YEAR (MOSY) ASSESSMENTS FOR THE ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM

Schools Division Superintendents To

- 1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum titled ADMINISTRATION OF THE FOR (MOSY) ASSESSMENTS MIDDLE-OF-THE-SCHOOL-YEAR ACADEMIC RECOVERY AND ACCESSIBLE LEARNING (ARAL) PROGRAM dated November 11, 2025, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), advises the field of the conduct of the said assessments in accordance with DepEd Order No. 18 s. 2025 titled Implementing Guidelines of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning Program and DepEd Memorandum No. 64 s. 2025 titled Implementing Guidelines for the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning Program in Reading for Key Stages 1 to 3.
- 2. The MOSY Assessments shall be administered to Grades 1 to 10 learners as part of the ongoing implementation of the ARAL Program.
 - For Grade 1, all learners shall take the MOSY Assessment (Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment [CRLA]). Results will determine their participation in the ARAL Program.
 - For Grades 2 to 10, only learners who are currently participating in the ARAL Program shall take the MOSY Assessments (CRLA for Grades 2-3; Philippine Informal Reading Inventory [Phil-IRI] for Grades 4-10). Results will guide tutors and teachers in determining appropriate next steps for each learner.
- 3. Details of the administration of the MOSY Assessments for SY 2025-2026, including links to the assessment tools, can be found in the attached memorandum from DepEd Central Office.

- 4. All schools are required to conduct the MOSY Assessments within the prescribed testing window, regardless of their SDO ARAL Program's start date or the number of sessions completed.
 - Schools that have already conducted the MOSY Assessments prior to the issuance of the Central Office Memorandum are exempted from retesting.
- 5. Upon completion of the MOSY Assessments, all schools must encode the results via the submission link: https://bld.deped.gov.ph/submission no later than December 16, 2025.

This Memorandum provides guidance on the conduct of the middle-of-the-school-year (MOSY) assessments for the implementation of the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program in accordance with Republic Act No. 12028¹, its Implementing Rules and Regulations, and DepEd Order (DO) No. 18, s. 2025,² and DepEd Memorandum (DM) No. 64, s. 2025³.

The MOSY assessments shall be administered to Grades 1 to 10 learners as part of the ongoing implementation of the ARAL Program.

All schools shall administer the MOSY assessments within the prescribed testing window, irrespective of the program's start date or the number of sessions completed. Schools that have administered the MOSY assessments prior to the issuance of this Memorandum shall no longer be required to do so again.

Table 1 presents the details of the administration of the MOSY assessments for School Year 2025-2026.

The MOSY results of the CRLA for Grade 1 shall determine their participation in the ARAL Program, while for Grades 2 to 10, the results shall guide tutors and teachers in identifying the appropriate next steps for each learner.

All schools are required to encode the results of these assessments after the completion of the MOSY assessments through the submission link: https://bld.deped.gov.ph/submission, not later than December 16, 2025.
