To: Schools Division Superintendents

- Relative to Unnumbered Memorandum dated October 17, 2025, the Bureau of Education Assessment in collaboration with the National Educators Academy of the Philippines through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct the Training of Teaching and Teaching-Related Personnel on the Alignment of Classroom and National Assessment from October to November 2025.
- 2. This activity aims to strengthen the capacity of teaching and teaching-related personnel by equipping them with the knowledge and skills to construct classrooms assessment items aligned with the structure, format and quality of those used in national and international large-scale assessments.
- 3. The training will be implemented through two modalities. Batch 1 will be conducted online via Microsoft Teams from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 nn. 
