- In reference to DepEd Memorandum OASOPS-2024-11-604¹, this Office, through the Education Support Services Division, cordially requests confirmation of compliance from all SDOs with the prescribed participant selection and adherence to the given timeline for the implementation of SBTCA.
- 2. As reiteration, at least fifty percent (50%) of all secondary schools nationwide must have two (2), one male and one female, trained and certified career advocates.
- 3. Likewise, the Department of Education is committed to the Asian Development Bank (ADB) to meet the timeframe of completing the training, which is due by October 2025.
- 4. In line with this, all SDOs are requested to confirm compliance with the conduct of SBTCA in their respective divisions. 
