Further, the following criteria should be used for the selection of teachers:

- Must be a teacher from a public school implementing the Kindergarten to Grade 10 or the Strengthened SHS Curriculum;
- Must hold a permanent plantilla position of at least Teacher III;
- Must have a minimum of five (5) years of teaching experience in the relevant subject area and handled classes in the Revised K to 10 Curriculum or Strengthened SHS Curriculum;
- Must possess a Bachelor's degree aligned with the subject area or specialization; and
- Must demonstrate collaboration, commitment, and the ability to provide comprehensive and constructive feedback.

Meanwhile, school leaders shall be selected based on the following criteria:

- Must be a school head or administrator from a public school implementing the Kindergarten to Grade 10 Curriculum or currently piloting the Strengthened SHS Curriculum;
- Must hold a permanent plantilla position (e.g., Principal, Head Teacher, or equivalent);
- Must have at least three (3) years of experience in a school leadership role;
- Must demonstrate active involvement in curriculum implementation and school-based management;
- Must possess a strong track record in promoting instructional leadership, collaboration, and continuous improvement within the school; and
- Must be able to provide comprehensive and constructive feedback on curriculum implementation during the monitoring activity.
