The **Grand Health Teaching** of the Special Health Sciences Senior High School is an initiative designed for students preparing for careers in the medical and health sciences. It aims to develop their capacity to promote community health through effective education. Students are trained to identify pressing health concerns, design appropriate instructional materials, and deliver sessions that encourage healthy practices and disease prevention. This program nurtures essential skills in communication, collaboration, and critical thinking, while instilling a sense of social responsibility and compassion—qualities vital to their future roles as healthcare professionals.

What are the topics of the Grand Health Teaching 2025?

-Not in order-

- Personal Health & Hygiene** – Proper grooming, oral care, sleep, and hygiene practices during adolescence.
- Substance Use and Abuse** – Effects and prevention of smoking, vaping, alcohol, and illegal drugs.
- Sexual and Reproductive Health** – Puberty, reproductive system, and responsible sexual behavior.
- Nutrition and Eating Habits** – Balanced diet, proper meal planning, and addressing malnutrition/obesity.
- Mental and Emotional Health** – Stress management, coping skills, and dealing with anxiety or depression.
- Role of social media** – Evaluating the role of social media in the welfare of adolescents.
- Injury Prevention, Safety & First Aid** – Road safety, disaster preparedness, and basic first aid.
- Community & Environmental Health** – Waste management, pollution, and how the environment affects well-being.
- Healthy Relationships & Family Life** – Communication skills, peer influence, respect, and building positive relationships.
