**CONDUCT OF THE 2026 REGIONAL ATHLETIC
ASSOCIATION MEET (RAAM)**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**
Head of Private Schools, Elementary and Secondary Schools
All others concerned

1. The Department of Education Region IV-A CALABARZON announces the 2026 Regional Athletic Association Meet (RAAM), scheduled from March 4 to March 14, 2026, hosted by the Schools Division of Batangas City. This event will showcase the skills and talents of our young athletes across the region.
2. To ensure a fair and thorough selection process, screening and evaluation of documentation for athletes, coaches, assistant coaches, and chaperones will be conducted according to the schedule set by the Division Screening and Accreditation Committee Chairperson during in-house training. The Regional Screening and Accreditation Committee (RSAC) will carefully review all submissions to uphold the integrity of the competition. *(The schedule of Screening, Accreditation, and Interviews will be issued in a separate memorandum.)*
3. Core team composition guidelines allow for the inclusion of **three modified players**, following **OM-OUOPS-2025-05-00833**, "Conduct of the 2025 Palarong Pambansa," dated February 4, 2025. These rules aim to foster an inclusive team environment while ensuring regulatory compliance.
4. All participants must strictly adhere to submission deadlines for documentation. Failure to comply will result in the automatic disqualification of the respective athlete(s) and/or team(s) from the 2026 Regional Sports Competitions. Timely compliance is essential.
5. All Chairpersons of Working Committees, Tournament Managers, and Technical Officials must attend the Solidarity Meeting on March 6, 2026, at 1:00 PM at the Batangas City Sports Coliseum. All officiating officials are required to attend a Refresher Course on March 5, 2026, at 8:00 AM, also at the Coliseum.

6. Officiating officials must submit a Medical Certificate, signed by a government physician, to their respective Tournament Managers upon registration. A complete list of officials and committee members will be released in a separate memorandum.
7. To strengthen the Region's grassroots sports program, selected events will be conducted as Demo-Sports. *(Please refer to the attached list.)*
8. For **team sports**, a modified **"winner-take-all" policy** will apply in selecting school sports club representatives for the Palarong Pambansa.
9. For measurable sports, including athletics, swimming, and archery, qualifying distances, times, and points set by the Palarong Pambansa will be strictly observed.
10. Coaches, assistant coaches, chaperones, trainers, delegation members, and technical officials who render weekend services will be entitled to **Service Credits** and **Compensatory Overtime Credits (COC)** for teaching and non-teaching personnel, based on actual participation during the 2026 RAAM.
11. Members of the Working Committees and Technical Officials will be provided with meals and snacks, but must remain with their respective division delegations.
12. Travel expenses for Working Committee members and Technical Officials shall be charged to local funds, in accordance with standard accounting and auditing regulations.
