**Regional Memorandum**

**ON-SITE MONITORING OF THE DIVISION-LED TRAINING OF  
TEACHERS ON THE REVISED GRADES 6, 9, AND 10  
CURRICULUM**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 044, s. 2023, this Office, through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD), in collaboration with the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD) and the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), shall undertake on-site monitoring of the Division-led Training of Teachers on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum. The activity will be conducted on the dates and at the venues specified in the attached schedule, with the aim of ensuring alignment with prescribed standards and guidelines for professional development implementation.
2. This monitoring activity aims to ensure that the conduct of the Division-led Training of Teachers on the Revised Grades 6, 9, and 10 Curriculum adheres to the established quality standards and implementation protocols. It seeks to assess the effectiveness, relevance, and fidelity of training delivery, thereby supporting continuous improvement and ensuring that intended learning outcomes for participants are achieved.
3. The on-site monitoring team shall be composed of Regional Functional Division Chiefs, Education Program Supervisors (EPS), Senior Education Program Specialists (SEPS), Education Program Specialists II (EPS II), and other Regional Office personnel who have been duly trained in the Monitoring and Evaluation of professional development programs. This composition ensures a comprehensive and technically sound assessment of the training implementation.
4. All monitoring personnel and officials from the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and the Regional Office are expected to strictly observe the provisions of Republic Act No. 6713, particularly Section 7(d). This provision prohibits public officials and employees from soliciting or accepting, directly or indirectly, any gift, gratuity, favor, entertainment, loan, or anything of monetary value in the course of their official duties or in relation to any transaction that may be affected by the functions of their office, thereby upholding integrity and professionalism in all monitoring activities.
5. For reference and guidance, please see the attached Monitoring Tool and the official list of designated regional monitoring personnel. These documents provide the framework, indicators, and procedures for the conduct of the monitoring activity.
