**MONITORING OF THE OPENING OF CLASSES
FOR SY 2026-2027**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**
Regional Functional Division Chiefs
All Concerned Personnel

1. Pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 009, Series of 2026** or the Guidelines on the Implementation of the Three-Term School Calendar in Basic Education, this Office through the Quality Assurance Division (QAD) and Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), announces the conduct of Monitoring of the Opening of Classes for SY 2026-2027 on **June 8-11, 2026**.
2. This monitoring activity aims to ensure that Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs) effectively provide the necessary technical assistance and submit timely, accurate, and comprehensive reports. These reports shall cover key areas such as compliance with established policies, learners' academic outcomes, implementation of the End-of-Term Block, and indicators related to teacher workload. This process is essential in promoting accountability, data-driven decision-making, and continuous improvement across all levels of program implementation.
3. All monitoring personnel and officials from the SDOs and Regional Offices are expected to strictly adhere to the provisions of Republic Act No. 6713. In particular, Section 7(d) mandates that public officials and employees shall not solicit or accept, whether directly or indirectly, any form of gift, gratuity, favor, entertainment, loan, or anything of monetary value in the course of their official duties or in connection with any regulated operation or transaction. Upholding this standard ensures integrity, transparency, and professionalism in the conduct of all monitoring activities.
4. For guidance and reference, please see the attached Monitoring Tool and the official list of designated regional monitoring personnel. These documents outline the scope, indicators, and procedures for the conduct of monitoring. Furthermore, this issuance shall serve as the official travel authority for all

monitoring team members identified therein, authorizing them to undertake their assigned functions in accordance with existing policies and regulations.

5. A virtual orientation for all Regional Office (RO) monitors will be conducted on May 29, 2026, at 9:00 AM via Microsoft Teams. The session aims to clarify roles and responsibilities, discuss key monitoring guidelines, and ensure alignment on protocols and expectations. The meeting link will be shared with all participants at least one hour prior to the scheduled activity.
6. Travel and other related expenses of the regional office personnel/officials relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against regional funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
