**IMPLEMENTATION OF BATCH 2 REMEDIATION READING
PACKAGES USING THE ENGLISH READING KIT
AND WIKAHON**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. The DepEd Region IV-A CALABARZON, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division – Learning Resource Management Section, continuously supports initiatives aimed at strengthening learners' reading proficiency. In line with this commitment, the Office shall conduct another batch of orientation on the utilization of the English Reading Kit and WIKAHON to further assist schools in implementing effective reading remediation interventions for struggling readers.
2. All Schools Division Offices (SDOs) included in Batch 2 are directed to ensure the participation of identified Reading Teachers based on the number of recipient schools that received the Remediation Reading Packages for Year 2025. The Learning Resources (LR) Supervisor/Coordinator and the Reading Supervisor may coordinate to identify and consolidate the official list of participants for the orientation. The preferred schedule and grouping of participating SDOs are attached in Enclosure 1, while the implementation guidelines on the utilization of remediation reading packages are provided in Enclosure 2.
3. The orientation aims to guide the proper utilization and implementation of the remediation reading packages to maximize their effectiveness in improving learners' reading comprehension and literacy skills in both English and Filipino.

**IMPLEMENTATION GUIDELINES ON THE UTILIZATION
OF REMEDIATION READING PACKAGES**

A. Distribution and Utilization

1. The English Reading Kit and WIKAHON shall be distributed to designated recipient schools based on the validated results of the Comprehensive Rapid Literacy Assessment (CRLA) or any Division-initiated reading assessment conducted by the Schools Division Office (SDO) to ensure equitable allocation of resources.
2. The English Reading Kit and WIKAHON are supplementary learning resources intended to support reading instruction and intervention activities. These materials may be utilized by teachers during reading classes, remediation activities, and implementation of the ARAL Program to strengthen learners' reading comprehension and literacy skills.

B. Orientation and Training

1. The orientation on the effective utilization of the English Reading Kit and WIKAHON shall focus on Reading Teachers from recipient schools of the Remediation Reading Packages for Year 2025.
2. The LR Supervisor and Reading Supervisor may coordinate to determine the appropriate participants based on the number of schools that received the remediation reading packages.

C. Monitoring and Evaluation

1. Division English and Filipino Coordinators shall lead the monitoring and implementation of the remediation reading packages within their respective divisions.
2. Schools shall submit progress reports and updates on the utilization of the materials to support continuous program improvement.
3. The Regional Office shall conduct periodic monitoring and provide technical assistance to strengthen the implementation of reading remediation interventions.

- D. All concerned personnel are encouraged to proactively support the implementation of these remediation reading interventions to further promote literacy development among learners.
