In reference to the Memorandum from the Office of the Undersecretary for Learning Systems dated May 14, 2026, titled **CONDUCT OF SCHOOL VISITS FOR THE MONITORING OF 2026 SUMMER REMEDIATION PROGRAMS**, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), informs the concerned Schools Division Offices (SDOs) and schools of the conduct of school visits relative to the implementation of the 2026 Summer Remediation Programs.

The said monitoring activity is in line with the Department's continuing efforts to address learning gaps through the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Summer Program, Summer Academic Remedial Program (SARP), and Senior High School (SHS) Remediation Program being implemented from May 6 to June 2, 2026.

The school visits aim to gather relevant information on the actual implementation of the program, particularly on the instructional and learning materials being utilized, number and deployment of DepEd and external tutors, tutor compensation arrangements and payment mechanisms, learner attendance and participation, and other implementation concerns and observations.

7. The monitoring team shall use the approved field monitoring tool and may conduct classroom/session observation, interview concerned personnel and learners, review implementation records, and gather photo documentation, as may be necessary.
8. Expenses incurred relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against available FY 2026 Current and FY 2025 Continuing Basic Education Curriculum (BEC) Funds, Local Funds, or other appropriate funds, subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
