CY 2026 MONITORING AND EVALUATION OF SCHOOL INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMS

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. Pursuant to the DepEd 5-Point Agenda, this Office, through the Education Support Services Division (ESSD), will conduct monitoring and evaluation of the School Infrastructure Programs, including Basic Education Facilities Fund, Last Mile School Program, Gabaldon Heritage Restoration, Public-Private Partnership, Infrastructure for Safer and Resilient Schools (ISRS), and Quick Response Fund (QRF).
2. The activity aims to ensure that the programs are implemented in compliance with the laws, rules, regulations, and other relevant issuances of the department. This will also support the initiative to provide a conducive learning environment for the safety and well-being of learners.
3. The Regional Office (RO) monitoring officials are the ESSD Chief Education Supervisor, Regional Engineer, and DepEd Project Engineers and Architect under Contract of Service.
4. The Schools Division Offices (SDO) through the School Governance and Operations Division shall assist the RO monitoring officials during the time of inspection.
5. Relative to this, a quarterly coordination meeting will be conducted to address updates and concerns regarding the implementation of programs and projects. A virtual coordination meeting with the concerned SDO shall be facilitated by the Regional Office, if necessary. On the other hand, a post-coordination meeting will be called within a month if found urgent and necessary.
6. Enclosure 1 provides the target schedule, venue, and expected participants relative to the schedule of monitoring at Schools Division Offices.
7. Travel and other related expenses of the RO Monitoring Officials relative to the conduct of this activity will be charged against the regional funds, while that of the SDO will be charged against their local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
