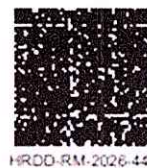

**ADVANCED GENDER SENSITIVITY RETOOLING FOR DEPED
CALABARZON GAD LEARNING FACILITATORS**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. In line with the continuous strengthening of Gender and Development (GAD) implementation in the Region, DepEd Region IV-A CALABARZON, through the Regional GAD Focal Point System (GFPS), will conduct the *Advanced Gender Sensitivity Retooling for DepEd CALABARZON GAD Learning Facilitators* on August 26-28, 2026. The venue will be communicated in a separate memorandum.
2. This activity is an offshoot of the **Training of Trainers on Gender and Development (GAD)** conducted on June 17-19, 2026. As members of the regional pool of GAD Learning Facilitators (LFs), the participants are expected to serve as resource persons and facilitators in GAD-related learning and development activities across schools and Schools Division Offices (SDOs). To effectively perform these roles and eventually become strong GAD champion, there is a need to further enhance their gender sensitivity competencies and strengthen their capacity to facilitate GAD learning and development interventions.
3. Specifically, the activity aims the participants to:
 - a. deepen their understanding of gender sensitivity and emerging GAD issues;
 - b. apply gender-sensitive approaches in facilitating GAD-related activities; and
 - c. strengthen their commitment to promoting gender equality as GAD Champions.
4. The participants in this activity are the identified DepEd CALABARZON GAD Learning Facilitators from the Regional and Division Offices. Please refer to the attached list of participants. 5. Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity, such as food and accommodation for the participants, honorarium for the resource persons, tokens for the invited guests, and travel expenses of the regional office participants shall be charged against local funds/GAD funds. While travel and other relevant expenses of the SDO participants relative to their participation in the said activity shall be charged against their SDO local funds/GAD funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
