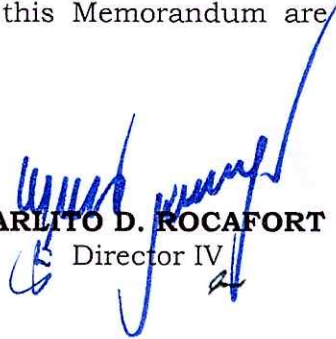
**SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE SYSTEMS INNOVATION ON

MANAGEMENT AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE DELIVERY**

To: **Schools Division Superintendents**

1.  - d. identify replicable and sustainable innovations that may be adopted or enhanced by other Schools Division Offices; and
 - e. foster collaboration and continuous improvement among the Regional Office and Schools Division Offices in advancing participatory school governance and responsive technical assistance delivery.
